The Energy Efficient Home Improvement Tax Credit (25C) provides a federal tax credit to homeowners who install high-efficiency equipment. The amended Energy Efficient Home Improvement Credit begins in 2023 and extends through 2032.

## **Tax Credits**

- Tax credits up to \$600 for gualified air conditioners or gas furnaces
- Tax credits up to \$2000 for qualified heat pumps, heat pump water heaters, or boilers.
